Polls will be open for the February 17<sup>th</sup> election from 7am to 8pm. Up for consideration is the State Superintendent of Public Instruction and the Circuit Court Judge Branch 3. Wards 1,2,3,4 & 10 vote at Town Hall, and Wards 5-9 will vote at their new location, Fire Station No. 2. The fire station is located north of Five Corners at 1350 Covered Bridge Road. ## 35-Gallon Refuse Carts Now Available

The Town just received a new shipment of refuse carts. The impetus behind this shipment of carts was the selling out of 35-gallon carts in 2008. Town approved refuse carts are required to be purchased by owners of new home construction, and are required of all residents by January 1, 2011. The Town currently offers three cart sizes at the following prices: 35 gallon at \$38, 65 gallon at \$54, and 95 gallon at \$58.
