The Comprehensive Park Plan serves as the official park planning document for the Town of Cedarburg. In addition to providing background information on our park and bicycle facilities, the Plan also outlines acquisition and development recommendations for existing and new parks, such as the Sports Complex and Covered Bridge Park.
