RESOLUTION NO. 12-55

OPPOSING WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WISDOT)
CORRIDOR PRELIMINARY ALTERNATIVES FOR HIGHWAY 60

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is currently studying the WIS 60 corridor from US 45 in Jackson to 11th Avenue in Grafton; and

WHEREAS, WIS 60 is an extremely important corridor for Ozaukee County businesses and residents; and

WHEREAS, WisDOT states a major goal of the study is to produce a preferred alternative that will improve the safety along the corridor, while at the same time provide an efficient highway that can support the current and future capacity needs along this portion of WIS 60; and

WHEREAS, the two bypass options will have a deleterious effect on the businesses that currently exist in the WIS 60 corridor; and

WHEREAS, both the city and town of Cedarburg have approved resolutions opposing the two bypass options and excessive right-of-way expansion; and

WHEREAS, WisDOT schedule calls for the refining of alternatives by the end of 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ozaukee County Board of Supervisors does hereby oppose WisDOT's preliminary alternatives for the WIS 60 corridor, including the bypass options and excessive right-of-way expansion.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Ozaukee County Board of Supervisor recommends using the current alignment/route.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the WisDOT be encouraged to work with the local governments to establish an acceptable right – of – way.

FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Ozaukee County Board of Supervisors that the County Clerk shall forward a copy of this resolution to the Governor of the State of Wisconsin, Ozaukee County's Legislative Representatives, Wisconsin Secretary of Transportation, Town and Village of Grafton, and Town and City of Cedarburg.
