## **Town of Cedarburg Awards First Annual Five Corners Matching Grants**

At its regular meeting on September 5th, the Town Board awarded matching grants totaling \$5,000 to three businesses in the Five Corners area. The Town Board decided to evenly split the \$5,000 between each of the winning applicants, which were ATACO Steel Products, Cedarburg Auto Park, and Skateland. All three businesses plan to install new entrance signs and two of the three will also add landscaping around their new signs.

Earlier this summer, the Town created the Five Corners Matching Grant program to encourage area businesses to plan and implement beautification projects such as façade improvements, landscaping, adding/modifying entrance signs or pedestrian lighting, constructing/repairing sidewalks, and other related enhancements. Eligible businesses are located along STH 60 between Horns Corners Rd. and CTH I and those approximately a half mile north and south of STH 60.

“The Town is thrilled to partner with these local businesses to enhance the heart of the Town’s commercial district,” stated Chairman Dave Valentine.
