## **Town Accepting Applications for Five Corners Matching Grant**

*Five Corners Businesses Have Until May 15<sup>th</sup> To Apply*

Now in its third year, the Five Corners Matching Grant program offers financial assistance to businesses looking to enhance the appearance of their property. These improvements can be oriented toward the beautification of a building façade or business entrance, including construction of or improvements to landscaping, adding/modifying entrance signs or pedestrian lighting, constructing/repairing sidewalks, or other such related enhancements.

This year, the Town will match up to a total of \$5,000, which could be awarded to one or split among several businesses. Past recipients include Cedarburg Auto Park and ATACO Steel, which were awarded grant money in 2007 for signage improvements. In 2008, Five Corners Dodge Chrysler Jeep received \$5,000 for building facade enhancements.

Eligible businesses are those that are located along STH 60 between Horns Corners Rd. and CTH I and those approximately a half mile north and south of STH 60. Applications have been mailed to eligible businesses and are also available online at [www.town.cedarburg.wi.us](http://www.town.cedarburg.wi.us) or at Town Hall. The application deadline is Friday, May 15<sup>th</sup>.

The Five Corners area has long been the heart of the Town's commercial activity. In recognition of the importance of this area, the Town has spent a tremendous amount of time and resources planning for the growth and development of Five Corners. As a result, the Five Corners master plan and design guidelines were crafted to aid developers and property owners in the creation of site plans and buildings that respond to the desired character traits of the Five Corners Town Center.
