Field Naming Highlights Little League Opening Day - June 2nd

Field #2 becomes Allison Kasten Field

On Monday, June 2nd, what has been known as Field #2 at the Orthopaedic Hospital of Wisconsin Fields (OHOW Fields), home of [Cedarburg Little League](#), will be renamed Allison Kasten Field. The Town Board accepted a generous offer for naming rights to the field from the Craig Kasten family earlier this spring.

The field naming ceremony will be held at 5:45pm and feature the unveiling of the new sign atop the fence on Field #2 by Craig Kasten. The Orthopaedic Hospital of Wisconsin Fields are located at 1220 Five Corners Drive, just west of the Five Corners intersection and south of STH 60. The field naming ceremony is the highlight of Opening Day festivities for Cedarburg Little League. Games will be held following the ceremony.

The naming rights payment, combined with all other sponsorship and fundraising since the inception of Town recreation programming amount to over \$140,000 collected as of late May 2014. This generosity from the community is the very foundation for the successful Little League program.

Sponsorships and donations will continue to improve the OHOW Fields in 2014. Planned additions accepted by the Town Board include a second equipment shed and two scoreboards as part of Eagle Scout projects. Sponsorships like the Kasten's have allowed for the purchase of a pitching machine, infield material to rebuild the playing surface, an infield groomer to keep the playing surface consistent for everyday play, and a large amount of new equipment to replace aging pieces.
