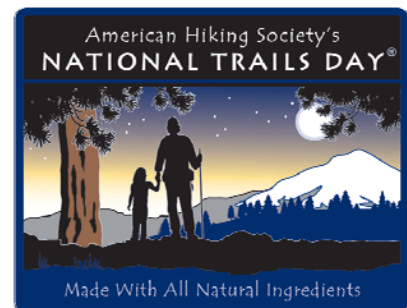
Cedarburg Trails Day Held on June 4th *A free, family-friendly event at Pleasant Valley Nature Park*

The Town is hosting the second annual Cedarburg Trails Day at Pleasant Valley Nature Park on Saturday, June 4th from 10am to 1pm. The park is located at 5100 Pleasant Valley Road just one-half mile east of CTH I. This FREE event is part of the American Hiking Society's National Trails Day®. Take a hike led by Riveredge naturalists or feel free to "blaze your own trail" through this 88-acre park. This family-friendly event offers a great opportunity to experience the hidden treasures within this park, including walking trails, an elevated boardwalk path, an observation platform, kettles, an open prairie, a bog, and Mole Creek! Bring a picnic basket for lunch or enjoy reasonably priced food and drinks offered by the Five Corners Lions Club.



Although the main event will be held at Pleasant Valley Nature Park, area residents are also encouraged to celebrate the day by using the Cedar Creek canoe/kayak access points located at Creekside Park, Cedar Creek Farms Canoe Launch or Krohn Park.
