Community Survey Aims to Help Shape Town's Future

Town Residents and Businesses Urged to Return Survey by April 30th

The Town of Cedarburg is encouraging all residents and businesses in the Town to participate in a community survey. The survey, which is a part of the Town's ongoing comprehensive plan update, gives residents and businesses a unique opportunity to help shape the Town's future.

The survey was mailed today inside the Town's Spring newsletter. The purpose of the survey is to receive feedback on a variety of topics, including housing, economic development, transportation, community facilities and services, open space, and other public policy issues facing the Town.

The survey is just one of several ways the Town is seeking resident and business input on the comprehensive plan. "Public participation is an extremely important part of the comprehensive planning process. Our residents have responded quite well to previous community surveys and we hope that continues with this survey," stated Town Chairman Dave Valentine.

The Town began an update of its comprehensive plan earlier this year with the appointment of twenty-three residents to serve on an Ad-Hoc Comprehensive Plan Committee. The public is encouraged to attend the monthly committee meetings to discuss the various parts of the plan. One of two public workshops will be held in June to review the results of the community survey. Additional information regarding the Town's comprehensive plan can be found on the Town's website.

Completed surveys can either be mailed to Town Hall or dropped off at Town Hall or the Town Recycling Center during normal business hours. Town Hall is open Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and the Recycling Center is open Thursday's Noon – 6:00 p.m. and Saturday's 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.. The survey deadline is Monday, April 30th.
