Town “Greens” Refuse Policy
Televisions No Longer Accepted in Refuse Collection

As a part of the Town’s ongoing commitment to the environment, the Town will no longer accept electronics, including televisions, with regular refuse pickup. In the past, the Town had accepted televisions at the curb, as well as a few other electronics.

Effective immediately, Town refuse crews will no longer accept any electronics. If electronics are left out for pickup, the refuse crew will tag the item, can or cart, notifying the resident the Town is not able to accept electronics. This policy identifies electronics as hazardous waste, as does the Veolia landfill transfer station to which the Town delivers refuse. Hazardous waste cannot be disposed of in a landfill due to the high level of lead in the glass portion of the television.

Residents can dispose of electronics at the Hazardous Waste Facility operated by Veolia at 1275 Mineral Springs Drive in Port Washington. The facility is open every Monday from 8am to 5pm.
