Dear Mikko,

Last night, the Town Board discussed your request for monetary and labor assistance to paint the Cedarburg Community Pool. The Town Board rejected this request for two reasons. First, the total cost (labor and materials) would exceed the Town's 28% share because two of the five painters would be Town employees and the Town is already paying for a portion of your and the Recreation Supervisor's salaries. In total, the labor costs would exceed the Town's 28% share.

The second reason the Town Board rejected this request is because our public works crew will already be shorthanded for the next month due to the short term disability of one of our public works crew members. If two of our crew members are working on the pool for several days it will jeopardize the Town's ability to provide basic services such as garbage collection.

The Town remains willing to provide labor assistance for pool related work but the current request is not equitable or feasible for this unanticipated expense.
