Fiscal Year 2010 Budget Public Hearing

The Town will hold three separate budget related meetings on December 2nd. The first meeting will be a Special Town Board meeting at 7pm, during which the Administrator will make a presentation summarizing the proposed 2010 budget, followed by a public hearing. The proposed budget will cut the tax rate and total spending next year.

Immediately following the Special Town Board meeting will be a Meeting of the Electors. During this meeting, Town residents in attendance will vote to approve the 2010 highway expenditures, as well as vote to advise the Town Board on the fiscal year 2009 tax levy to be paid in 2010. The regular December Town Board meeting will follow and the Town Board will vote on the tax levy as well as the fiscal year 2010 Town budget.
