Town Receives \$157,888 in State Road Aid

West Portion of Pleasant Valley Road to be Improved

The Town of Cedarburg has been awarded \$157,888 in state funds to replace 1.2 miles of Pleasant Valley Road between CTH Y (Granville Road) and Lofty Lane. The Town of Cedarburg is the only town in Ozaukee County and one of only four in southeastern Wisconsin to be awarded funds through the State of Wisconsin's Town Road Discretionary Improvement Program (TRID).

The TRID Program provides state assistance for seriously deteriorating roads that require improvements totaling at least \$100,000. This competitive funding program pays up to a maximum of 50% of total eligible project costs. The remaining balance of the eligible costs is funded by the local unit of government. The \$157,888 awarded to the Town will cover approximately half the total cost of the Pleasant Valley Road project.

This section of Pleasant Valley Road has an average daily traffic of approximately 700 vehicles.

The Town now has up to five years to complete the improvements to Pleasant Valley Road. A decision on the timing of the project will likely be made by the Town Board later this year.
